BIDS**LEASE/PURCHASES FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT**

In addition one ladder truck from Heritage Equipment was purchased in the amount of \$843,714.00 with a yearly lease payment of \$94,151.25. This passed by a unanimous roll call vote.
